FINANCE

The accounts for Holy Rood Church are prepared on the basis of Receipts and Payments covering the year from 1st January 2023 to 31st December 2023. There are two accounts. One is the General Fund, which is used for most of the day to day receipts and payments. The other account is the Fabric Fund, which is a 'Restricted Fund' meaning the funds can only be used for the upkeep and improvement of the church and churchyard.

General Fund

The General Fund had total receipts of £67,935 in 2023 compared with £37,600 in 2022. Income was 80.7% above the previous year, we benefitted from a number of one off donations. Planned giving stabilised in 2023.

Expenditure has increased compared to the previous year by ca. £4,000 to £59,302 reflecting an increase in our planned donations, none were paid in 2022, due to an administration by the treasurer, who generated the cheques and letters, but misfiled them. Our insurance premium has stabilised.

Our main item of expenditure is the Parish Gift which is paid to the Diocese and helps to fund clergy pay and pensions, clergy housing and training. Our gift for 2023 was £26,000 In 2022 it was £28,700 compared to £29,100 in 2021. For 2023 we have offered to pay £25,000 as our contribution to Diocesan costs, plus repayment of the Diocesan energy donation of ca. £1,000.

The overall result is that the General Fund is showing a surplus of £8,632 in the year, 2023, reducing the balance carried forward on the General Fund at 31st December 2023 to £34,112, after the deduction of cheques issued which havent cleared and the addition of receipts which have not cleared.

Holy Rood Church was asked to keep the accounts in 2012 for grants from the Diocese for the Woodfield Team. These funds are kept within the General Fund bank account and £532 was left at the end of 2023 and is carried forward to 2024.

Fabric Fund

Receipts for the Fabric Fund totalled £96,175. There are now no planned giving amounts for the Fabric Fund.

Payments totalled £6,156, this was predominately spent on upgrading the electrical cabling outside. We purchased a fixed bond of £100,000, in order to maximise our returns.

At 31st December 2023 there was a balance of £177,228 carried forward on the Fabric Fund compared to £87,209 at 31st December 2022.

Overall Position

At the end of 2023, total reserves held were £177,228, excluding total liabilities of £7,957, which includes the amounts belonging to the Woodfield Team. We hold most of these reserves in a deposit account, in readiness for further planned work on the church.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR 2023

The financial statements of the Parochial Church Council have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts and Payments basis.

1. Tax efficient (planned) giving – 2023 - £22,375 (2022 £22,693 2021 £24,322, 2020 £25,44)

This is money received on a regular basis from parishioners who have signed a Gift Aid declaration. A renewal of the Funding Campaign ran in March 2014 with excellent results, providing a consistent level of income which has continued into the current year.

2. Other planned giving – 2023 – Zero (2022 £123 2021 £205, 2020 £119)

This is money, which is given on a regular basis through envelopes etc. but on which we are usually unable to reclaim tax.

3. Collection – 2023 – £1,454 (2022 £1,568 2021 £1,159, 2020 £251)

This covers plate collections taken at all services, including weddings and funerals. For 2020 and 2021, services were reduced firstly, through government restrictions and then latterly in 2021 by a lack of Clergy due to Leicester Diocese decision not to recruit for vacant clergy positions.

4. Donations

General Fund – 2023 - £3,266 (2022 £3,565 2021 £1,195, 2020 £1,330)

This General Fund received twenty-one one-off donations. The church floodlighting received four of the twenty-one donations.

Fabric Fund – 2023 -Zero (2022 £2,869, 2021 £72,646, 2020 £0, 2019 £140)

5. Tax Recovered

2023 - £4880 (2022 £4,976, 2021 £5,093, 2020 £5,165, 2019 £7,254)

This section includes all the tax recovered for the General Account. (i.e. from planned tax-efficient giving.

- 6. Fund Raising Activities 2023 £1182 (2022 £121, 2021 £46)
- 7. Ear Marked Funds (Restricted income and payments) see also note 8.

 These are funds which pass through the church account but which are for other (usually charitable) bodies and therefore not part of our normal income and payments
- 8. Woodfield Team funds.

During 2012 the Woodfield Team of churches held a Mission entitled "Jesus 2012" "Faith up to It". Holy Rood Church was asked to keep the accounts for the mission which involved grants and payments for events held during the mission. There remains £532 left in the account, which has been carried forward to 2023. It is included in our total liabilities, see note 13.

9. Charitable Giving.

The Pariachial Church Council (PCC), normally agrees the level of charitable giving at a PCC meeting. The charitable giving in 2023 was £3700, which included £600 to Crosslinks.

10. Parish Gift – 2023 - £26,000 (2022 £28,700 2021 £28,700, 2020 £29,100)

The Parish Gift is our contribution to the Diocese where it is used to pay and house clergy across the

Diocese as well as providing for training etc. As our Parish Gift for 2023 we have offered £26,000.

11. Regular Church Running Expenses

This includes the annual running costs for maintenance and upkeeping of services costs. Churchyard costs include the cost of a contractor mowing the churchyard.

12. Monetary Assets

On 31st December 2023 we held ca. £214,000 in the combined General and Fabric Funds. This includes £532 of Woodfield Team money, see note 8 and other liabilities, see note 13. The current reserves are essential to undertakle repairs to the churchyard boundary wall and other work highlighted in the last Quinquennial Inspection, including the tower roof replacement and electrical work.

13. Total Liabilities - £7,957

Packington Church holds £532 in the General fund for the Woodfield Team in respect of the balance of Diocesan grants to the team. The Fabric Fund includes restricted amounts of £737 for the upkeep of graves and churchyard and £488 for the "Bells" fund.
